This Privacy Statement/Policy describes how <https://www.nftfn.xyz/> ("NFTFN") collects, uses, and discloses personal information about you via its website, including web applications, mobile applications, protocol, and other digital/online products and services (collectively addressed "Services"), or when you interact with us in any other way.

"Personal Information" here refers to any information that, alone or in combination with other data, permits you to be either directly identified or indirectly, such as your IP address, email, device ID, or wallet address. Additionally, please be informed that we hold/reserve the right to change this Privacy Statement at any time. Any changes made by us to this Privacy Statement will be updated via the date at the top of the Privacy Statement. We may occasionally provide you additional notice (such as adding a statement to our homepage or sending you a notification). To stay updated on our information practices and your options, we recommend that you read the Privacy Statement whenever you use the Services or interact with us.

Please read the following carefully to understand what Personal Information we collect, how it is used, and how it can be shared.

1. COLLECTION OF INFORMATION

1.1 INFORMATION YOU GIVE US

When you sign up to use the Services or participate in any interactive features of the Services, we may request the following information:

- Email address so you can sign up for our newsletter and receive our communications. We do so with your permission.
- Contact information, such as your name, wallet address and any other information you choose to provide if you contact us via email for customer service or otherwise. We do so because it is necessary for us to provide you with our services.
- Public polygon addresses to track the user's journey through our interface. We aggregate and analyze these user journeys to provide adequate security while improving the overall user experience. We collect this information because we have a genuine interest in understanding how our site is used, and it also helps us gain insight into how to keep it secure.



- When you visit our website or send us an email, we collect information about you or your device. This information, by itself or in combination with other information about you, may be considered Personal Information. It contains your IP address, browser type, and version, as well as information about your visits, such as the dates and times you use our website, the length of visits to specific pages, information on page interaction such as mouse scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs, and so on, or. We use Cookies to collect all of this information. Please refer to our Cookies Notice section for more detail on collecting this information.
- Your unique handle or identifier or any other information when you interact with us through Twitter, Discord, Telegram or any other channel.
- Furthermore, we will confirm your ownership of the email address you provided and request a cryptographic signature using your Polygon network private key [Please read the Terms of Use and Privacy Policy carefully], which we will use to verify your ownership of the Network Address you provided. The term "Network Address" refers to the one-of-a-kind public key cryptocurrency identifier that points to a Network-compatible wallet where cryptocurrency can be sent or stored.

1.2 AUTOMATICALLY COLLECTED INFORMATION

When you access or use our Services, certain information is automatically collected by us, such as:

- Log information about your use of the Services, such as your browser type, app version, access times, pages viewed, IP address, and the page you visited before navigating to our Services.
- Device information about the computer or mobile device you use to access our Services, such as the operating system, version, unique device identifiers, hardware model, and mobile network information.
- Collection of information through cookies and various technologies, including web beacons.



Web beacons are software tools used to collect information about how you interact with our Services. They allow us to count users who have visited certain pages and to generate statistics about how our Services are used. We may also use third-party analytics providers and technologies, such as Google Analytics, to assist us with analyzing the usage of our Services. 1.3 INFORMATION FROM THIRD PARTIES

We may receive personal information about you from third parties, such as other users, social media platforms, or partners. If you have provided consent to a third party to share your information with us, we will have access to the personal information you shared with that third party.

2. USE OF INFORMATION

We use the information we collect to provide, maintain, protect, and improve our Services and develop new ones. More specifically, we use the information for the following purposes:

- To provide, maintain, and improve the Services, including providing technical support, updating the Services, personalizing your experience, and processing and completing transactions.
- Understand and analyze trends, personalize your experience, and develop and improve products and services.
- To communicate with you about the Services and for customer service purposes.
- To send you marketing and promotional communications, with your consent.
- To enforce our terms and conditions, protect our users' rights and safety, and comply with legal obligations.
- Provide support for the services including resolving issues and responding to your questions and feedback.
- Prevent, Detect and investigate fraudulent, abusive and fraud activities.



3. SHARING OF INFORMATION

3.1. We will disclose or share Your Personal Data, without notice, for the primary purposes for which it was collected in accordance with this Privacy Policy, including, without limitation:

- Where You have consented to such disclosure or sharing;
- Where permitted under the applicable Data Protection Laws;
- Where required under Applicable Laws;
- Where it is necessary to protect and defend the rights or property of NFTFN, our Service Provider and/or our users;
- Where it is necessary to act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of other users, or the general public visiting the Site.

3.2 Sharing with Service Providers: We work with Our Service Providers to execute various functionalities and We may share Your information with them to enable and better customize Our Services for You.

3.3 Sharing with group companies: Subject to Applicable Law, We may share any data, including Personal Data, that We collect from You with Our group companies for product research and development; making Our Services better; and tailoring the Platform for Your benefit.

3.4 Sharing with law enforcement when needed: We will share Your information, without prior notice, on a request from any competent governmental authority or a court of competent jurisdiction or law enforcement officers that We find appropriate or necessary in order to comply with Applicable Law.



4. DATA RETENTION

We may retain Your Personal Data for as long as it is necessary to fulfil the purpose for which it was collected, or as required or permitted by Applicable Law. We will cease to retain Your Personal Data or remove how the data can be associated with You as soon as it is reasonable to assume that such retention no longer serves the purpose for which the Personal Data was collected and is no longer necessary for legal or business purposes.

We take the security of your personal information seriously and have implemented measures to protect it from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. We sincerely strive to protect Your Personal Data, We cannot guarantee its security, or warrant that no harmful code will enter the Site (including but not limited to viruses, bugs, trojan horses, spyware, malware, forks or adware). You should be aware of the risks associated with disclosing any information or transacting over the internet or when using online portals.
